- _____ 1. One person in our event will say our school code and give the memorized introduction including the title and author before the scene or monologue. The rest of us are not moving or speaking.
- _____ 2. I plan to create any sound effects only through hands, feet or mouth.
- _____ 3. **I plan to wear approved DTASC clothing when I perform, and will never subtract any clothing including my shoes during my performance.**
- _____ 4. I'm aware that no props may be used at all, and that I can use up to 4 chairs in a scene (used in any manner other than throwing or propelling) and up to 2 chairs in a monologue.
- _____ 5. I'm fully aware of my time limits: 5 minutes for monologues and 2-4 person scenes, and 8 minutes for other scenes.
- _____ 6. I don't plan to use any transition material which is not from the text.
- _____ 7. I made sure that any music or lyrics we used for the Shakespeare Festival is Elizabethan in origin.
- _____ 8. I'm not planning to use any theatrical makeup at the Festival unless I'm in the costume event.
- _____ 9. I do not plan to take any large radios to the festival. I will also not smoke on campus.
