Looking for money for college?

DTASC has scholarships available for actors and techs!

If you have participated in at least 2 DTASC festivals from 2015 to now

If you have a GPA of at least 2.5

If you have a Theatre Arts GPA of at least 3.5

If your Theatre teacher will write you a letter of recommendation

If you complete the online application by March 7

If you audition on March 25

You could be a DTASC scholarship recipient!

How to prepare:

Written part of application (all included in the online pdf)

- 1. List your theatre experiences in high school. One page maximum.
- 2. How has theatre helped you in high school? 200 words maximum
- 3. Why would you major in theatre, TV or cinema? 200 words maximum
- 4. What have you gained from participation in DTASC festivals? 200 words maximum?

Audition part

- For acting, prepare 2 contrasting monologues: one must be classical, one may be from musical theatre or opera.
- For tech, present a technical portfolio exhibiting design work in the DTASC technical categories.

Once the Scholarship Chair receives your completed application materials, you will be assigned an audition time and location for March 25.
