Your Day at the Festival

Individual students may complete in up to two of four categories: monologues, duets, original oratory/poetry, and group scenes. Students will perform each of their events twice – once in the morning and once in the afternoon. A boxed lunch is provided for all participants.

In the morning sessions, the judges offer verbal feedback to the students, much like in a master class. In the afternoon sessions, the students perform again for a new panel of judges who will score the performances. While scores are being tabulated, students participate in high-energy theatre games.

The Categories:

Performances in all three categories are conducted under *audition conditions*. No costumes or sets. If required by scene, small hand props are acceptable.

Students may enter up to two of four categories:

Monologues – Maximum 3 minutes. One chair will be provided.

Duos– (2 person scenes) - Maximum 5 minutes. Two chairs will be provided.

Group Scenes - (3-15 actors) – Maximum 5 minutes. Four chairs will be provided.

Original Oratory Jam - A place to 'spit' your original poetry, monologues, performance art or interpret classic poems and speeches. Individuals or groups- Maximum 2 minutes.
